

Rules and Regulations for the use of the Law Books

1. ONLY Members of the Bar (“Members”) and Pupils-in-Chambers (“Pupils”) may use the Law Books (“Books”), one at a time. Members or Pupils may not bring any individual who is not a Member or a Pupil into the Bar Room to use or assist them in the use of the Books.
2. The Books are NOT to be taken out of the Bar Room.
3. Members and Pupils must register with the KLBC’s staff in charge of the Bar Room (“Bar Room staff”) before access is permitted to the Books. Personal identification must be produced upon request by the Bar Room staff.
4. Access to the Books shall be from 8:00am to 5:00pm [except between 1:00pm and 2.00pm] on Mondays to Fridays.
5. Photocopying is available at 30 sen per copy (black/white) and RM2 per copy (coloured). Please see the Bar Room staff for assistance.
6. Members and Pupils found mutilating or removing materials from the Books shall be liable to strict disciplinary action and would henceforth be barred from further access to the Books.
7. Personal belongings left unattended on the tables and chairs in the Bar Room shall be removed by the Bar Room staff. The Kuala Lumpur Bar Committee (“KLBC”) accepts no responsibility for any loss of personal belongings left unattended.
