



CHAIRMAN'S MESSAGE

A year has passed since this Committee was elected to office. The events of 1995/96 was significant for the challenges posed to the profession. The Bar was no exception. The entire legal system was under scrutiny in the media. The cry seems to be for accountability and transparency.

The move of the Kuala Lumpur High Court to Wisma Denmark brought untold problems. Some of these have been overcome. Others remain. The major one being inadequate parking facilities despite an early assurance that there were "adequate" parking facilities. The other, of course, is insufficient lifts during the peak hours. This move, we have been told, is a temporary one. We hope that it would be so. The move of the Subordinate Courts from Court Hill (the present site of Menara Maybank) to Jalan Duta, though described to be "temporary" lasted almost 20 years!

Information technology has taken the centre stage in the country. The Courts are soon to be computerised; the aim is to make the Courts "paperless". The KL Bar is proud to be part of this superhighway: we have our own home page on the Net. The incoming Committee, no doubt, would continue to develop our presence on the Net and make this more useful to members as well as the public. Legal firms too, with the proposed relaxation of the rules on advertisement, would want to acquire their own home pages on the Net as in Singapore, England and other countries.

Our Annual Dinner last year, the other significant event, was a success. Both the Chief Justice, YAA Tan Sri Dato' Haji Mohd Eusoff Chin and the Minister in the Prime Minister's Department, Y B Dato' Abang Abu Bakar graced the occasion together with many Judges. This is a return to tradition and collegiality which should be cultivated and nurtured.

What the KL Bar has done (or failed to do) is all revealed in the Annual Report. We have somewhat managed within the funds available to the Committee. On behalf of the Committee, I thank all the members of the K L Bar for their assistance and co-operation throughout the past year. Personally I wish to thank all members of the Committee who, despite their busy schedules, devoted their valuable time and energies in the work of the Committee.

1. 3rd ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

He attended a total of 7 meetings.

5. FINANCE

The financial position of the Committee remains stable with a sum of RM210,385.00 in Fixed Deposit. Details of the financial position are as set out in the Audited Accounts ending 31.12.1995.

The amount in the Fixed Deposit is inclusive of a RM30,000.00 reserve which the Committee has set aside for the upgrading of the Secretariat's computer system.

6. SUBSCRIPTIONS

The subscription for the year 1995 was fixed at RM100.00 at the 3rd Annual General Meeting of the Kuala Lumpur Bar held on 16.3.1995.

According to the records kept by the Secretariat, up to 31.1.1996, 159 members are still in arrears of the 1995 subscription.

7. NUMBER OF MEMBERS

As at 31.1.1996, the Kuala Lumpur Bar has a total of 3319 members.

10. BAR ROOMS

10.1 At the Wisma Denmark High Courts and Jalan Raja Subordinate Courts

The KL Bar was allocated a Bar Room each at both the Wisma Denmark High Courts and Jalan Raja Subordinate Courts.

The Bar Room at Wisma Denmark is located on the 8th Floor and the Bar Room at the Jalan Raja Subordinate Courts is on the ground floor facing Jalan Tun Perak.

The Committee had furbished both Bar Rooms and installed facsimile machines and photocopiers for members' use at a fee.

Refreshments continued to be sold at both Bar Rooms.

The total cost for furbishing the two Bar Rooms and the installation of equipment was RM29,120.00.

Smoking is disallowed in both Bar Rooms. The Rooms are also strictly for members' use only. Members' co-operation is sought to observe the same.

10.2 At Bangunan Sultan Abdul Samad

The Bar Room at Bangunan Sultan Abdul Samad was handed back to the Bar Council when the High Courts moved to Wisma Denmark in April 1995.

11. BAR COMMITTEE DOCUMENT BOXES

In view of the demand for Bar Committee Document Boxes at both the Wisma Denmark High Courts and Jalan Raja Subordinate Courts, additional boxes were installed at both Courts. New boxes were also installed at Bangunan Sultan Abdul Samad, which currently houses the Federal Court, Court of Appeal and Criminal High Courts, to cater for those firms which frequently use these Courts.

All circulars and bulletins issued by the Committee for circulation to members of the KL Bar were and would continue to be placed in the Document Boxes at the Jalan Raja Subordinate Courts. Members are advised to check their respective boxes frequently so as not to miss out on any information and/or activities of the KL Bar Committee.

It has been reported that many of the Committee's circulars and bulletins were left behind by clerks who were sent to collect documents from the boxes. It is hoped that all members would ensure that their clerks take back to the office all circulars and/or bulletins issued by the Committee.


15. ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

The attendance at each session was overwhelming, some members having to stand right through the talks or sit on the floor due to space constraints at the Bar Council Auditorium. There was no charge for these talks. Admission was free though seats were not guaranteed.

The Committee wishes to place on record its profound gratitude to all the speakers for having sacrificed their valuable time and for having contributed so immensely for the benefit of our members. A wide spectrum of subjects were covered.

The Committee also wishes to thank participants for their useful suggestions and contributions at the talks.

3. CHAMBERING PUPILS AFFAIRS

Meeting with chambering pupils

Throughout the course of 1995, the Committee met with the chambering pupils 19 times. These meetings were preceded by a lecture conducted by one of the Committee members on important matters that chambering pupils should know during their period of pupillage.

Petitions for Admission

A total of 712 Petitions were received in 1995. In the same year 756 members were called to the Bar in Kuala Lumpur. 505 members who were called to the Bar in 1995 joined legal practice in Kuala Lumpur.

One very noticeable trend with respect to Admission to the Bar is the increasing number of lady lawyers as can be seen in the statistics below:

Errors in Call papers

The Committee is appalled at some of the mistakes made by chambering pupils in their Call papers which mistakes could have been avoided by more careful scrutiny. Some of the avoidable mistakes were e.g. wrong Identification Card nos., wrong spelling of names, citing of wrong sections, confusing "kuasa" for "kausa" in Short Call applications.

Handbook for chambering pupils

To assist chambering pupils in the filing of various documents as well as to remind them of important matters which they ought to know during their period of pupillage, the Committee has published a handbook for pupils which is available at RM2.00 per copy (to defray printing cost). Chambering pupils are also advised to use the Forms printed by the Bar Council for the filing of Petitions, Short and Long Call papers.

Problem of getting a Master

At the meetings with chambering pupils, it was discovered that some of the pupils had had difficulties finding a Master to chamber under. There had been instances of some having to write about 40 letters and wait for more than a month before finding a Master who was prepared to take them in.

Going by the number of Practitioners with more than 7 years standing at the Bar in Kuala Lumpur which stands at 1249 as at 31.12.95, this problem of inability to find a Master to chamber under should not have arisen. Perhaps members of the Bar qualified to take in pupils should consider it their responsibility to take at least a pupil each under their wing and provide the necessary training to aspiring members of the Bar.

Problem of getting a Mover

There is also the perennial problem of pupils not being able to find a practitioner of 7 or more years of standing at the Bar to move their Calls. Masters of pupils are reminded that it is their duty to assist their pupils in getting a senior practitioner to move their pupils' Calls. It is not uncommon on the Call day itself for a pupil who could not find a mover to get someone who happened to be there to move someone else's Call. Such a practice should be discouraged as far as possible.

Late arrival for Call

The Committee views with great concern the problem of pupils not arriving in Court on time on their Call day inspite of reminders issued by Committee members who conducted the lectures for chambering pupils. Fortunately, the number of such cases were few and far between.

Venue for Call

When the High Court moved to Wisma Denmark in April 1995, Calls were conducted in the Appellate & Special Powers Division of the High Court at Wisma Denmark. The Courtrooms in Wisma Denmark were very much smaller compared to the Courtrooms at Sultan Abdul Samad Building. On a typical Call day, it is not uncommon for the Courtroom to be filled to the brim with parents, relatives and well-wishers of the pupils being called. Recommendations have been made that Call ceremonies for lawyers be held at Sultan Abdul Samad Building where the Courtrooms are much bigger and access to it is much easier for those who are unfamiliar with Kuala Lumpur.

4. PUBLIC RELATIONS

Courtesy Calls

This Sub-Committee was formed for the purpose of liaising with various Bodies/Authorities which the Legal Profession often comes into contact with. During the year under review, courtesy calls were paid on the following:-

The Committee is still attempting to meet the Registrar of Companies, Registrar of Businesses and the Official Assignee & Receiver before the expiry of its term. Its attempt to fix a meeting with the Wilayah Persekutuan Land Office was futile.

The meetings with the Judiciary and various Bodies/Authorities proved to be very fruitful. Matters of mutual interest and problems were discussed during those meetings and a pipeline for channelling complaints was established to foster closer relationship.

Get-together tea functions

Two get-together tea functions with the Judiciary were organised:

- i) With the Judges, Deputy Registrars and Senior Assistant Registrars of the High Court at Wisma Denmark on 21.7.95.
- ii) With the KL Sessions Court Judges, Magistrates, Registrars, EO, Chief Police Prosecutor and Deputy Police Prosecutor on 30.6.95 in the Bar Room at Jalan Raja Subordinate Courts.

5. SOCIAL

Annual Dinner & Dance

The main task for the year under review was to organise the Annual Dinner & Dance. Since the start of its term the Committee had identified The Legend Hotel and after some months of preparation the Annual Dinner & Dance was held on 27.10.95. The function was a resounding success especially with the participation of the Judiciary this year. At least 16 Judges attended with the Chief Justice, YAA Tan Sri Dato' Haji Mohd Eusoff Chin being the special guest of honour. The other invited guests were the Minister of Law in the Prime Minister's Department, YB Dato' Abang Abu Bakar bin Datu Bandar Haji Mustapha, Industrial Court Chairmen, Mr Tan Kim Siong, Tuan Zainal Abidin bin Mohd Wazir and Tuan Haji Yussof Ahmad, the Deputy Director-General of Dewan Bandaraya, Mr Lau Lee Ching, the Dean of Law from ITM, Puan Zita Fahmi, the Director of CLP, Encik Khalid Yusoff and heads of various Professional Bodies.

About 500 members attended the function which had a traditional and modern dance presentation by school children from the Convent Bukit Nanas and a solo performance by Andrew Lecci.

Apart from a few shortcomings, in particular the lucky draw prizes, the function fostered closer relationship amongst members of the Judiciary and the Bar and also amongst the senior and younger members of the Bar.

2. PEMBANGUNAN UNDANG-UNDANG

Jawatankuasa Kecil Pembangunan Undang-Undang telah dibentuk pada tahun 1995 apabila didapati adalah perlu untuk memaklumkan ahli-ahli mengenai perkembangan-perkembangan terkini berkenaan undang-undang, prosedur dan mengemaskinikan mereka dengan perubahan serta pindaan undang-undang. Siri ceramah ini (12 kesemuanya) seperti yang disenaraikan di bawah, disifatkan sebagai amat berjaya memandangkan maklumbalas yang diterima daripada ahli-ahli. Kehadiran pada setiap sessi adalah memberansangkan, beberapa ahli terpaksa berdiri sepanjang ceramah atau duduk di atas lantai kerana kesempitan ruang di Auditorium Majlis Peguam. Tiada sebarang bayaran dikenakan bagi ceramah-ceramah ini. Masuk adalah percuma tetapi tempat duduk tidak dijamin ada.

Pihak Jawatankuasa ingin merakamkan penghargaan yang amat tinggi kepada semua penceramah kerana mengorbankan masa yang berharga mereka dan kerana sumbangan yang amat besar untuk faedah ahli-ahli kita. Satu spektrum subjek yang luas telah diliputi.

Pihak Jawatankuasa juga ingin mengucapkan terima kasih kepada para peserta di atas cadangan-cadangan serta sumbangan-sumbangan mereka yang berguna di ceramah-ceramah itu.

Akhir kata tetapi tidak kurangnya, pihak Jawatankuasa juga ingin menghulurkan ucapan terima kasih kepada Presiden serta Majlis Peguam kerana telah mengizinkan penggunaan Auditorium Majlis Peguam tanpa mengenakan bayaran.

HAL-EHWAL PELATIH-PELATIH DALAM KAMAR

Perjumpaan dengan pelatih-pelatih dalam kamar

Sepanjang tahun 1995, pihak Jawatankuasa telah mengadakan perjumpaan dengan pelatih-pelatih dalam kamar sebanyak 19 kali. Perjumpaan-perjumpaan ini didahului dengan satu kuliah yang disampaikan oleh salah seorang ahli Jawatankuasa tentang perkara-perkara penting yang perlu diketahui oleh pelatih-pelatih di sepanjang tempoh latihan mereka.

Petisyen-petisyen Kemasukan

Sejumlah 712 Petisyen telah diterima pada tahun 1995. Pada tahun yang sama seramai 756 orang ahli telah diterima masuk sebagai Peguam di Kuala Lumpur. Seramai 505 orang ahli yang diterima masuk sebagai Peguam pada tahun 1995 menjalankan amalan guaman di Kuala Lumpur.

Suatu arah aliran ketara berhubung dengan Penerimaan Masuk sebagai Peguam adalah peningkatan bilangan peguam wanita sepertimana yang dapat dilihat melalui statistik di bawah:

Kesilapan-kesilapan di dalam suratcara-suratcara Penerimaan Masuk

Pihak Jawatankuasa amat terkejut terhadap beberapa kesilapan yang dilakukan oleh pelatih-pelatih dalam kamar di dalam suratcara-suratcara Penerimaan Masuk mereka, yang mana kesilapan-kesilapan ini seharusnya dapat dielakkan melalui penelitian yang lebih berwaspada. Diantara kesilapan-kesilapan yang boleh dielakkan tersebut adalah, contohnya, kesilapan nombor nombor kad pengenalan, kesilapan ejaan nama, memetik seksyen-seksyen yang tidak tepat, kekeliruan menggunakan perkataan "kausa" bagi "kuasa" di dalam permohonan permohonan Perintah sementara menanti Penerimaan Masuk.

Buku Panduan untuk pelatih-pelatih dalam kamar

Bagi membantu pelatih-pelatih dalam kamar di dalam pemfailan pelbagai dokumen dan juga bagi mengingatkan mereka tentang perkara-perkara penting yang mereka sepatutnya tahu dalam tempoh latihan dalam kamar, pihak Jawatankuasa telah menerbitkan sebuah buku panduan untuk pelatih-pelatih yang boleh diperolehi pada harga RM2.00 senaskah (bagi membayai kos percetakan). Pelatih-pelatih dalam kamar adalah juga dinasihatkan supaya menggunakan Borang Borang yang dicetak oleh Majlis Peguam untuk pemfailan Petisyen-Petisyen, suratcara-suratcara bagi Perintah sementara menanti Penerimaan Masuk serta suratcara-suratcara Penerimaan Masuk.

Masalah mendapatkan seorang Pengajar

Di dalam perjumpaan perjumpaan dengan pelatih-pelatih dalam kamar, adalah didapati sebahagian pelatih-pelatih menghadapi kesukaran mendapatkan seorang Pengajar dibawah siapa mereka boleh menjalani latihan guaman. Ada juga kalanya sesetengah daripada mereka terpaksa

menulis sehingga lebih kurang 40 pucuk surat dan menunggu sehingga lebih sebulan sebelum menemui seorang Pengajar yang sanggup menerima masuk mereka.

Mengikut kepada bilangan Pengamal Undang-Undang yang melebihi 7 tahun di dalam Bar Kuala Lumpur, yang mana bilangannya adalah seramai 1249 orang setakat 31.12.1995, masalah ketidakupayaan untuk mendapatkan seorang Pengajar dibawah siapa boleh menjalani latihan guaman tidak seharusnya timbul. Mungkin ahli-ahli yang berkelayakan mengambil pelatih-pelatih patut menganggap ianya sebagai tanggungjawab mereka untuk mengambil sekurang-kurangnya seorang pelatih setiap seorang di bawah bimbingan mereka dan memberikan latihan-latihan yang perlu kepada mereka yang berhasrat untuk menjadi ahli Bar.

Masalah mendapatkan Pengusul

Terdapat juga masalah yang tidak berkesudahan di mana pelatih-pelatih tidak berkeupayaan mendapatkan seorang pengamal yang telah mengamal selama 7 tahun atau lebih bagi mengusulkan Petisyen Penerimaan Masuk mereka. Pengajar-Pengajar adalah diingatkan bahawa adalah menjadi kewajipan mereka untuk membantu pelatih-pelatih mereka mendapatkan seorang pengamal yang kanan bagi mengusulkan Petisyen-Petisyen Penerimaan masuk pelatih-pelatih mereka. Bukanlah sesuatu yang luar biasa, pada hari Pembicaraan Penerimaan Masuk itu sendiri, pelatih yang tidak dapat mencari pengusul akan mendapatkan seseorang yang kebetulan berada di sana untuk mengusulkan Penerimaan Masuk pelatih lain. Amalan-amalan sedemikian, sejauh mana yang mungkin, tidak harus digalakkan.

Kelewatan hadir pada hari Pembicaraan Penerimaan Masuk

Pihak Jawatankuasa memerhati dengan penuh kebimbangan masalah pelatih-pelatih yang gagal hadir ke Mahkamah pada masa yang tepat di hari Pembicaraan Penerimaan Masuk mereka sekalipun pelbagai peringatan telah diberikan oleh ahli ahli Jawatankuasa yang menjalankan kuliah untuk pelatih pelatih dalam kamar. Mujurlah bilangan kejadian sedemikian adalah kecil dan jarang berlaku.

Tempat tempat bagi Pembicaraan Penerimaan Masuk

Apabila Mahkamah Tinggi berpindah ke Wisma Denmark pada bulan April 1995, Pembicaraan Penerimaan-Penerimaan Masuk telah dijalankan di Bahagian Rayuan dan Kuasa-Kuasa Khas di Mahkamah Tinggi di Wisma Denmark. Ruang-ruang Mahkamah di Wisma Denmark adalah jauh lebih kecil berbanding dengan ruang-ruang Mahkamah di Bangunan Sultan Abdul Samad. Pada hari Pembicaraan Penerimaan Masuk, bukanlah sesuatu yang luarbiasa bagi ruang-ruang Mahkamah dipenuhi sesak oleh para ibubapa, saudara-mara serta tetamu-tetamu pelatih-pelatih yang diterima masuk. Cadangan-cadangan telah dibuat supaya majlis-majlis Penerimaan Masuk bagi peguam peguam diadakan di Bangunan Sultan Abdul Samad di mana ruang-ruang Mahkamah adalah jauh lebih besar dan jalan masuknya adalah lebih mudah bagi mereka yang tidak begitu biasa dengan Kuala Lumpur.

KUALA LUMPUR BAR COMMITTEE

1. MANAGEMENT PANEL'S REPORT

- 1.1 Upon taking office, the Panel commenced with an exhaustive Evaluation & Planning session of its activities. The outcome was that some structural changes were recommended and subsequently implemented.
- 1.2 The monthly MP meeting has been now geared to focus on policy shaping and program development. To achieve this, an Exco was created which met practically every Friday afternoon to handle management and operational issues.
- 1.3 A further radical change was the move away from traditional approach to legal aid to provide the much needed emphasis to advocacy of issues. A wholistic approach was planned resulting in the creation of Working Group for HIV/AIDS; Migrant Workers; Trafficking in Women and Gender Issues. Research; Law Reform; Representation and Advocacy strategies were planned. It is hoped that more working groups will be established to tackle other emerging issues.
- 1.4 Another structural change that was implemented was the participation of NGO's in the MP itself. The Panel has been extended to include representation from 3 NGO's i.e. Pink Triangle; Tenaganita and Awam based on those organisations' activities with the LAC. The benefits accruing have been immense. A change from 'top- down' planning to participatory planning has been accomplished. Emphasis has also been made in the approach to delivery of legal services from the traditional dependency relationship with recipient organisations to one of creating self reliance and empowerment.
- 1.5 Major achievements are the launching of the Dock Brief Scheme and the completion of the Centre's Office Systems Manual for volunteers. Particular appreciation to the ceaseless efforts of Allan Wong and Nahendran are recorded. The Centre had further prepared a comprehensive submission on the "Means Test" for consideration by the Bar Council Legal Aid Committee.

OPERATIONAL ACTIVITIES

2 ONGOING PROJECTS

2.1 Pudu Jail

The clinic is still operational every Wednesday from

2-00 to 4-00 p.m. 176 inmates were interviewed and provided assistance.

2.2 Chambering Students Programme

The programme is now into its 25th session involving 450 students.

The programme is structured for duration of 12 weeks with 18 student participants. 3 students are rostered for duty from 1.00 to 4.00 p.m. under the supervision of a lawyer. The students are also provided a full day introductory programme where they are introduced to areas of law that are commonly handled at the legal aid clinics.

However there is a change in the module in that chambering students are given a briefing subsequent to which only those interested in volunteering their services are placed in the programme. At the End of Term Review, the students are given a run down on the various projects and are encouraged to volunteer their services to the Centre after their call.

2.3 Syariah Clinic

The clinic opens on Wednesdays from 2-00 to 4-00 p.m. at the LAC. 36 clients were given advice.

Since the beginning of 1995, the Syariah Sub-Committee has been pushing for a place to set up a Legal Aid Centre Clinic at the Kuala Lumpur Syariah Court Building (i.e. next to the KTM Building). Unfortunately, due to Government bureaucracy, we are still waiting for a confirmation from the Syariah Court.

2.4 AWAM Clinic - Women's Issues

This clinic commenced on 8/9/94 at the premises of AWAM at 11, Jalan Bukit Mentri Selatan , Petaling Jaya on Thursdays from 2-00 to 5-00 p.m.

26th March, 1995 and at The Valley Country Club Subang Jaya on 23rd September, 1995.

2.11 Annual Get Together

The Panel organised an annual get-together of volunteers at Penthouse, Dewan Bandaraya on 15th December 1995. It was attended by some 85 participants. It also provided the opportunity for feedback from volunteers and NGOs.

3 NEW PROJECT

3.1 Magistrate Court Dock Brief

The purpose of this project is to provide assistance and representation for application for bail and/or mitigation for convicted persons who require such assistance and are unrepresented.

This project commenced on 31/7/95 at Magistrate Ct 3. Due to the fact that this Court is not a relatively busy one, the project was subsequently extended to Magistrate Ct 1 with effect from 20th September, 1995 and we hope to extend it to other Courts and to S117 remand applications.

4. MANAGEMENT/ADMINISTRATION

4.1 Finance

A sum of RM196,894.00 was approved by the Bar Council Legal Aid Committee for the Centre's operation for the year 1995. (Please refer to annexure "A".)

4.2 Contribution







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




