Admitted as an Advocate & Solicitor of the High Court of Malaya before and possess a valid practising certificate or pending issuance of a practising certificate (need to provide proof of application)

Pupils-in-Chambers, Law Students / Registered OKU

Pupils undergoing their pupillage or completed their pupillage and pending hearing of their Petition for Admission as an Advocate & Solicitor of the High Court of Malaya

Law undergraduates (must provide valid student card or enrolment letter from university/college)

Law graduates pending CLP (within one year from date conferred with LL.B) (need to provide letter of confirmation from Law College to confirm enrolment for the CLP intake)

Registered OKU to send a copy of OKU Card together with registration

Non-members

No legal qualifications

With legal qualifications but were never admitted as an Advocate & Solicitor of the High Court of Malaya

Admitted as an Advocate & Solicitor of the High Court of Malaya but do not possess a valid practising certificate i.e. not in practice

Students pursuing their Masters or PhD and non-Law related degrees
